

DLPAA Membership Benefits and Privileges

Effective July 1, 2016

Eligibility

Any Brother of DLP, who meets the membership criteria of “Alumni” status, as defined in the Fraternity By-Laws, is eligible for membership in the Alumni Association.

Membership Dues Allocation

Membership dues collected supply the DLPAA’s annual budget with resources necessary to carry through its programs. A listing of programs is available at www.dlp.org/alumni. A portion of membership dues is allocated for direct DLPAA member incentives. Membership dues do not contribute to the DLPAA funding programs, which include, David L. West Convention Assistance Fund, Tim Ortyl Memorial Conference Travel Fund, or Shining Knight Fund. Separate funding campaigns support these programs.

Membership Tiers FY 2017

New Graduate: \$25—New graduates and new alumni are eligible for this rate 90 days before and after their alumni conferral date. Details below.

Annual: \$50—Standard rate of new annual membership and renewal membership.

Lifetime: \$750—Guarantees benefits of annual membership for life. Payment plan available by emailing alumni@dlp.org.

Annual Membership Duration

Annual membership (including new graduate membership) is extended through the current fiscal year. New members who join between May 1– July 31 will have their membership extended through the following fiscal year.

New Memberships

New Graduate: New alumni can gain membership, and take advantage of the promotional rate, until 90 days after their alumni conferral date. Summer graduates will have their membership through the next fiscal year. Winter graduates will have their membership through the current fiscal year.

Annual: Alumni can become Annual members of the DLPAA anytime during the year. Memberships beginning May 1 - August 30 will be valid through the following fiscal year. Memberships beginning between September 1 - April 30 will be valid through the end of the current fiscal year.

Lifetime: Alumni can become Lifetime members of the DLPAA anything during the year. Membership continues for life.

Renewals

Renewal of memberships will take place between May 1 - August 30 of each year. Renewals are valid for the following fiscal year.

New Graduate/New Alumnus Verification

The DLPAA will use two methods, by confirming a status change on MyDLP and submission of the New Alumni Survey. Visit www.dlp.org/alumni for details.

Past Members & Grandfathered Lifetime Members

Any alumnus who is listed as a DLPAA Lifetime Member on MyDLP prior to June 30, 2016 will retain all rights and privileges of Lifetime Membership. Any Brother who believes he is entitled to membership within the Alumni Association based on past financial or other contributions can request that the fee for basic membership at the time of said membership be waived. This request should be made in writing to the Alumni Affairs Committee Clerk, and waivers will be granted on the merits by a simple majority of the Alumni Affairs Committee.
